I can hardly believe how quickly this term is flying by! The **Primary 1 children and children new to our ELR are now well settled** into their classes and are enjoying being part of the larger Harestanes Family!

Thank you to all of the parents who continue to support our SAFE TRAVEL arrangements by not coming into the school playground and instead waiting outside the school gates for pick up. I would also like to remind everyone that parents are not permitted to drive into the school car park to pick up or drop off (ELR pupils have bespoke arrangements) for the safety of all of our pupils. Our school garden was very overgrown after the summer but with the support of the local **Brownies** who meet in the **Harestanes Community Huts every Wednesday** and our volunteer parent it is almost clear before the winter months. We were delighted to take part in **Fairtrade Fortnight** from the 9th September to the 22nd September. We **welcomed Howard**, a **Fairtrade farmer from Malawi** to our Friday assembly. Howard told us all about growing rice and about how **Fairtrade helps children** in his community go to school. This links to our learning about the UNCRC and Global

Goals. We also organised and ran a very successful **Fairtrade tuckshop** at lunchtimes in **conjunction with Gavin's Mill, Milngavie**. Thank you to everyone who supported this. We sold out of many items including our Fairtrade chocolate and whistles! Our children are making a difference and helping others.

Our School Improvement Plan 2024/25 and our Standards and Quality Report 2024 are now on our school website. Having achieved our Silver Reading School Award last year, we are on track to achieve our Gold Award this year! We will also be working towards becoming a Rights Respecting School (Silver Level) and more information about this will be sent out to parents very soon. We will also be working on continuing the development and implementation of RSHP (Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenting Programme) this year.
